

Trial List (things to consider taking with you to a K9 Nose Work trial)

Your dog! (*and the NACSW booklet*)

FOR YOUR DOG

Your dog's gear: Competitive harness, collar, leash **and** walking collar and leash

A red bandana if you have a reactive dog

Your trial rewards (food treats or toy)

Water and water bowl

Poop bags

Dog towel(s)

Paper Towel

Your dog's dinner (for the end of the trial)

Paperwork (rabies certification, NACSW booklet, CGC/CGN, microchip info)

Weather dependent:

Hot

Pop up tent (with sides)

Shade blanket(s) and magnets

Window shades

Fan(s) (enough batteries to last the day)

Spray mist bottle

Cool coat

Cool crate pad

Cold

Blanket(s)

Hot pads (for crate)

Dog coat

Dog booties

FOR THE HANDLER

Clothing (weather dependent but layering is good)

Shoes – CLOSED TOED and rubber soled (2 pairs!)

Water

Hat and/or gloves

Cool neck kerchief

Passport*

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

First aid kit: including wraps, bandages, tape, epi-pen*, tweezers, medications

Garbage bag (for trash; to wear as an emergency rain coat; keep rain off a crate)

Cash (to participate in raffles)

Cell phone plug in charger

Book

Sunglasses

Suntan lotion

Eyeglasses*

Cooler

Thermos

Lunch and a variety of snacks

Of course if you are staying overnight before the trial, you will need to bring appropriate items for the care and comfort of yourself and your dog, including a sheet for the hotel bed.

* if needed
